- Film 2 videos of your performance(s) – 2 videos of contrasting pieces for solo piano from two different eras of classical music including Baroque, Classical, Romantic and Twentieth Century must be performed memorized.
- Make sure you announce clearly your name and title of selection at the beginning each of your videos. (not counted within the time limit)
- Make sure your hands, face, feet, and keyboard are visible.
- You do not need to upload sheet music.
